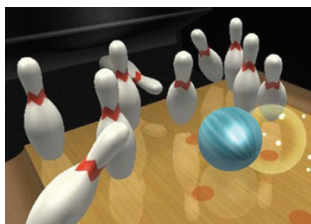
Spend the evening at the Library with our community's stars! Enjoy delicious treats and listen to stories
